The show will run November 26-28, December 3-5 and December 10-12 at the club building, located on Jefferson Avenue off Route 22 east in Union, New Jersey behind The Home Depot. The show times are: Fridays, 5-7 pm, Saturdays noon to 9 pm and Sundays, noon to 6 pm.
