Ticket prices are \$5.00 for adults, \$2.00 for children aged 12 and under and \$3.00 for seniors aged 60 and over, if purchased in advanced. The show features the Club's 1,600 square foot HO Scale layout. A 30 by 27 foot, double-decked N Scale layout is also featured, as well as outdoor and indoor garden railroad display loops. Visitors will also be able to view the progress that has been made on the 60 by 80 foot addition to the HO Scale layout and enjoy displays in the gallery area.

The sound and light show is a perennial favorite with children and adults alike. It is the organization's major fund raising event for the year and proceeds from admission donations and purchases made at the Club's gift shop and snack shop will help fund the Club's activities.
